

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the Long Street from 400m south of its junction with Penhill Road for a distance of 40m in the PARISH OF GREAT ELLINGHAM because of new electrical connection work.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 20th March 2017 to 24th March 2017 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Long Street, Wroo Road, A11, B1077 Ellingham Road/Attleborough Road, Chequers Lane, Long Street.


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

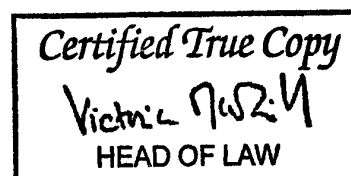

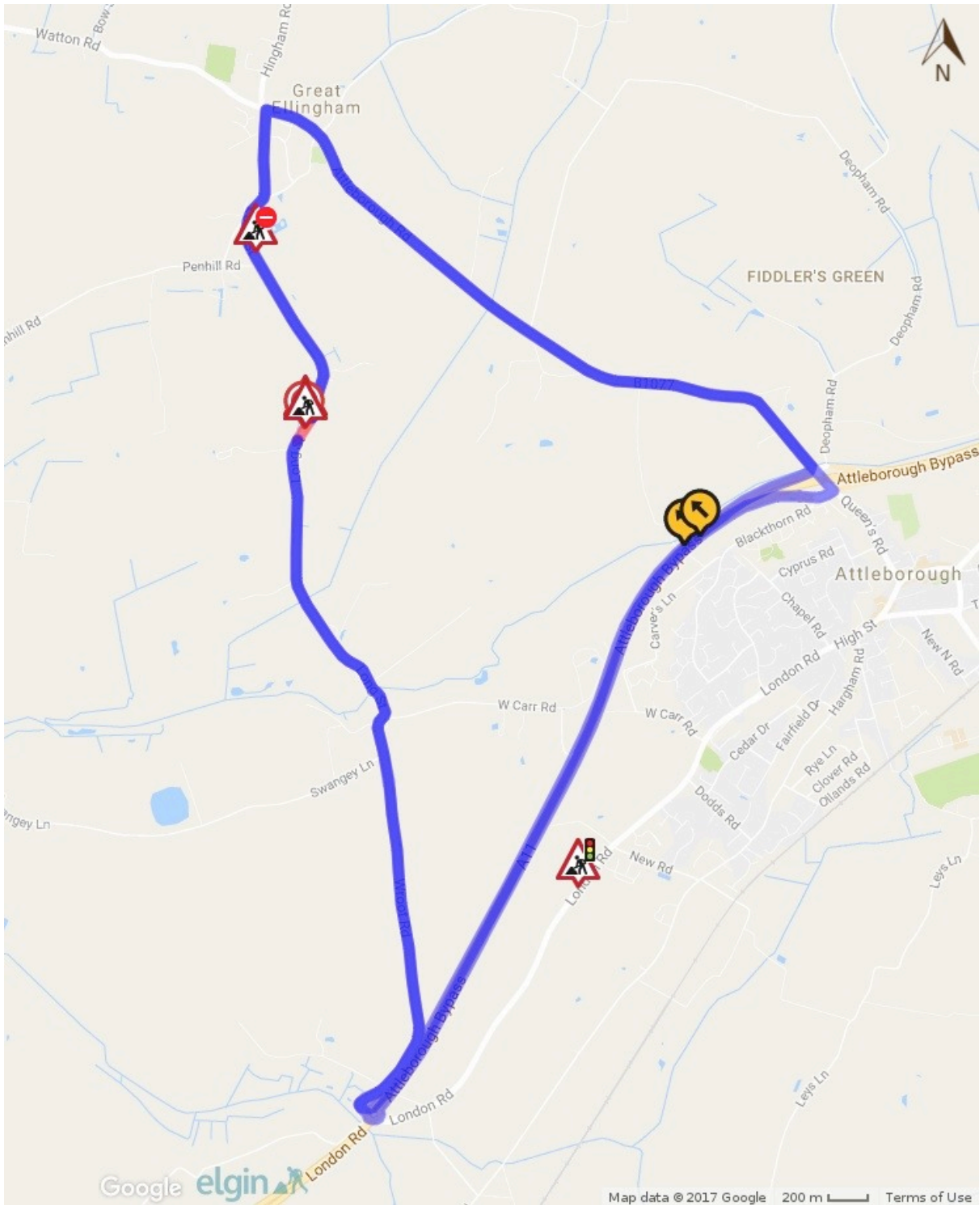
