



## Parish Councillor Vacancy

Great Ellingham Parish Council has a vacancy for one Councillor. If you have an interest in local issues and are willing to represent your community, please contact the clerk for further information.

This is a voluntary role and training can be provided. The Parish Council meets on the third Wednesday of every month and meetings usually last for around an hour and a half.

To qualify, you must be 18 years old or over, be a UK, Commonwealth or EU citizen and must meet one of the following four conditions:

- a) You are registered in the parish as a local government elector.
- b) You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the parish for the previous twelve months.
- c) Your main or only place of work during the previous twelve months has been in the parish.
- d) You have lived in the parish or within three miles of the parish boundary for the previous twelve months.
